Founded in 1997, Cityscape Holdings Inc. is an integrated residential and commercial development company with a focus on historic properties.

The principals of the company established their reputation for quality with a number of historic loft conversions and restorations in Toronto, including The Movie House, The Wellington Worx Building, The Baseball Glove Factory and Brockton Place.

Cityscape's greatest success has come with the Distillery Historic District and its creation of an authentic, pedestrian-oriented village, currently the city's most popular new arts, culture and entertainment destination. It was a conversion that has led to numerous awards including the Best Large Project Award from the Canadian Urban Institute, the Heritage Toronto Award for Architecture, Conservation and Craftsmanship, the Ontario Association of Architects Business Award of Excellence, and the City Renewal Award from the Canadian Urban Institute.

Together with its partner, Dundee Realty, Cityscape has forged yet another phase in the evolution of the Distillery District, with the addition of three new condominium towers. Designed by award-winning architect Peter Clewes, the Pure Spirit, Clear Spirit and Gooderham condominium developments have been among the city's most successful new residential projects.
