Beyond the boutiques and cafes, the site includes over 40 cutting-edge businesses whose offices are found in the converted brick and beam buildings throughout the site. From design firms to ad agencies to film production companies, some of Canada's coolest office based businesses are working at the Distillery.

The District also offers the most unique concentration of gallery spaces whose exhibits and areas of focus are varied, from historical and contemporary photography to Canadian and international paintings, sculptures and installations.

The Distillery is proud to be the home to some of the finest performing arts companies from across Canada and the world. Some of the Distillery's world-class theatres include the much acclaimed Soulpepper Theatre Company, and the Yonge Centre for the Performing Arts. The District is also home to Nightwood Theatre and Tapestry Opera, each of which has their own unique performance venues.

Host to one of the largest and most unique festival line ups in Canada, the summer months are filled with everything from music festivals to arts festivals, farmers markets to beer tasting events.
